One of the largest ski resorts in the United States is actually two resorts in one, a merger of Park City and Canyons Resort, boasting a total of 7,300 acres of adventure terrain, now owned by the venerable Vail Resorts. This strength in numbers amps up the property's variety, with groups having an extremely wide range of choice with regard to meeting space, accommodation, skiing and cost. And you just can't beat the jaw-dropping scenery, in any season.

Coming Together

Nestled in the spectacular Wasatch Mountains about a 35-minute drive from the Salt Lake City airport, Park City Mountain Resort sports more than 30 different meeting venues with a total of 125,000 sq. ft. of event space to choose from for retreats and conferences. There are more than 100 lodge properties to consider, many of them just steps from the slopes.

Working the Legs

In the winter, the skiing and snow-boarding here is as superb as you would expect, with more than 300 trails, 41 lifts and eight terrain parks. Group-friendly off-mountain winter activities include snow biking, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and more. Long summer days are made for incredible hiking and world-class mountain biking, fly-fishing and golf, zip lining, scenic gondola rides, outdoor concerts and more.



Doing Up Downtime

Heated outdoor pools help take the sting out of an afternoon on the hills—and they're hot enough during the winter that you don't need a tuque. Be sure to carve out some time to wander through the Alf Engen Ski Museum at Utah Olympic Park before throwing on a helmet to hit the Winter Comet Bobsled track.

Savouring the Flavours

The Park City area's myriad restaurants—both at the hills and on the town's famous Main Street strip—consistently make Utah's top 10 lists, including The Farm at the Grand Summit Hotel and the aptly named Firewood. Adventure-seekers line up for shooters served in a ski at The Spur Bar & Grill, priming you for an evening of dueling pianos.





Getting There

Park City is a year-round destination, with the ski season running from late November to mid-April. Plan ahead while your options are the most open. Sidestep the Sundance Film Festival during the second half of January, when the roads, restaurants and ski runs are overrun with Hollywood folk and their entourages. parkcitymountain.com
